Notice of Updated SPICT (Lae) and MIT (Motukea) Tariffs: Adjustment Effective 1 March 2026

Dear Valued Clients,

Please be informed of the updated 2026 South Pacific International Container Terminal (SPICT) and Motukea International Terminal (MIT) Tariffs effective 1 March 2026, following thorough review and approval by PNG Ports Corporation in accordance with applicable contractual requirements.

SPICT and MIT Tariffs have remained unchanged since January 2023, translating to price stability and predictability for three years.

The updated Stevedoring and Handling Tariffs reflect a maximum average adjustment of 6.3% aligned with Consumer Price Index (CPI) movements since 2023, as published by the PNG National Statistical Office (NSO). **No changes to handling charges for laden containers.**



Section 1: SPICT and MIT Performance

Since 2018, SPICT's and MIT's average vessel time at berth has been reduced by half, while average volumes per vessel call have continued to grow. These productivity gains have translated into substantial time and cost savings for port users.

The 2025 PNG Ports Corporation report on the performance of SPICT and MIT confirms sustained improvements at both terminals since operations began in 2018, with the most significant gains recorded from 2023 following the introduction of Ship-to-Shore (STS) cranes in Lae and additional Mobile Harbour Cranes (MHC) in Motukea.

These achievements have been made possible through SPICT's and MIT's continued investment in equipment, technology, safety, and continuous employee training and development.

Furthermore, a regional comparison of published public tariffs with neighbouring ports in Australia, East Timor, and Fiji shows that SPICT and MIT are positioned at the lower end of the tariff scale even with the CPI-based adjustment, while continuing to climb in global performance rankings as reflected in the 2025 World Bank Container Port Performance Index (CPPI).



The stevedoring rate shown includes crane charge for SPICT and all rates are calculated using a 1.28 TEU factor, reflecting the applicable tariffs for both 20-foot and 40-foot containers.

Section 2: SPICT and MIT 2026 Stevedoring and Handling Tariffs

The updated Stevedoring and Handling Tariffs reflect a maximum average adjustment of 6.3% aligned with CPI movements since 2023, as published by the PNG NSO.

The adjustments to the **Stevedoring and Handling Tariffs** are as follows:

1. **Container Tariff:** The average 6.3% CPI-based adjustment to the combined stevedoring and handling tariffs (Maximum Average Tariff, MAT) translates to the following:

- a. No changes to handling charges for laden containers.
- b. Average TEU rate adjustments to stevedoring and empty handling are as follows:

SPICT, Lae:

- Gateway Stevedoring:
 - +PGK 45 per TEU for laden containers
 - +PGK 36 per TEU for empty containers
- Transshipment Stevedoring:
 - +PGK 41 per TEU for laden containers
 - +PGK 34 per TEU for empty containers
- Empty Container Handling:
 - +PGK 11 per TEU

MIT, Motukea:

- Gateway Stevedoring:
 - +PGK 40 per TEU for laden containers
 - +PGK 35 per TEU for empty containers
- Transshipment Stevedoring:
 - +PGK 37 per TEU for laden containers
 - +PGK 32 per TEU for empty containers
- Empty Container Handling:
 - +PGK 7 per TEU

2. **Breakbulk Tariff:** NSO CPI adjustment of 6.3% (PGK 1.01) per revenue tonne (RT) on combined breakbulk stevedoring and handling tariff.

3. **Crane Charge (SPICT):** NSO CPI adjustment of 6.3% translating to:

- a. Container: +PGK 9.48 per container
- b. Breakbulk: +PGK 9.48 every 18 RT

Section 3: SPICT and MIT 2026 Tariffs not subject to the Maximum Tariff regime ('Other Tariffs')

The 2026 SPICT and MIT Other Tariffs do not reflect an inflation-based adjustment and remain unchanged apart from a few targeted adjustments to further enhance safety and operational efficiency in both terminals.

The specific adjustments to the **Other Tariffs** are as follows:

1. No increase to storage rates except for DG Class 1 and 7, which are adjusted to reflect the heightened risk associated with keeping these cargoes in the terminal.
2. Additional items have been introduced under non-declaration and misdeclaration charges to capture a wider range of occurrences.
3. The equipment rental schedule has been expanded to include new types of equipment, subject to a minimum two-hour rental fee or a per-day rate, where applicable.
4. The hatch cover lift rate is now equivalent to a 40-foot lift.
5. Additional items have been introduced under Services to capture a wider range of occurrences to support operational efficiency.
